# 2022-23 STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN

## The Health Insurance Plan Offers:

- Unlimited coverage for primary care providers, specialists, emergency visits and hospitals
- Unlimited coverage for preventative care, including annual physicals, GYN exams, routine screenings and immunizations
- Prescription Drug Coverage: \$20 copay for tier 1 drugs, a \$40 copay for tier 2 drugs and a \$70 copay for tier 3 drugs
- Unlimited coverage for mental health
- Evacuation and Repatriation Services
- Teledoc Service for minor sickness, injury & mental health

## Who is eligible?

The plan is mandatory for all freshmen, sophomores, juniors and athletes enrolled in 12 or more credit hours. Freshman, sophomores and juniors must enroll in or waive the Student Health Insurance Plan by September 30, 2022. These students will be automatically billed for the Student Health Insurance Plan.
